DAY THREE:

HILLTOWN ARTIST STUDIOS

Visit the home and studio of wood-fire potter, Mark Shapiro in Worthington, as well as Mara Superior's artist-built home, collection, and studio of sculptor Roy Superior in Williamsburg.

Enjoy lunch at Project Art, Cummington, and tour the resident studios of Sergei Isupov, Kadri Pärnamets and Paul Scott. View selected works by other Ferrin Contemporary artists on display in the summer gallery.

Continue on to more studios, Shelburne's Bridge of Flowers, and a drive along the Mohawk Trail.

DAY FOUR:

THE CLARK & WILLIAMSTOWN

Visit the Williams College Museum of Art, Williamstown.

Head over to The Francine and Sterling Clark Art Institute. Enjoy a docent-led tour of the architecture and the exhibitions. Explore the grounds and enjoy lunch on the Terrace.
