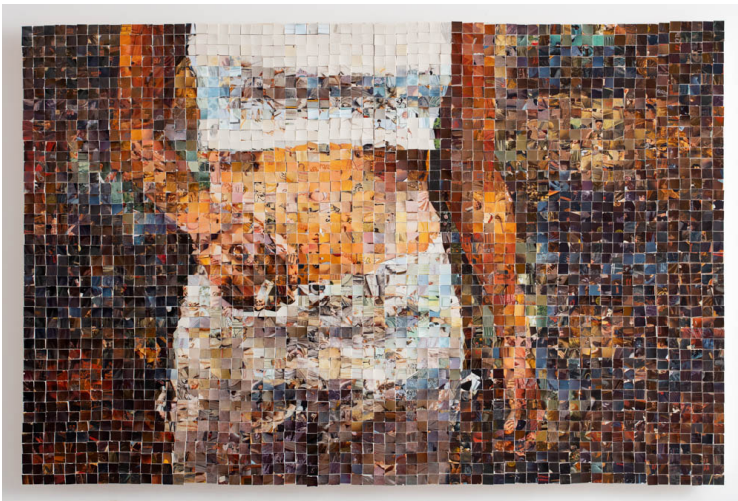




NIKI JOHNSON
