DAY ONE:

MASS MoCA CAMPUS IN NORTH ADAMS

Visit [Ferrin Contemporary](#) in Building 13 on the MASS MoCA campus.

Explore [MASS MoCA](#) with a 1-hour docent-led tour of the galleries. Call the Box Office at (413) 662-2111x8121 for the daily tour schedule.

Enjoy Craft Beer Tasting at [Bright Ideas Brewery](#), sandwiches at [Door Prize](#), and dinner at one of MASS MoCA's many year-round pop-up restaurant offerings.

DAY TWO:

GALLERIES, MUSEUMS, OR NATURAL BERKSHIRES

Visit galleries and museums in Lenox and Stockbridge such as [Schantz Galleries](#), [TurnPark Art Space](#), or [The Norman Rockwell Museum](#)

Hike a section of the Appalachian Trail

Rent a tube or [take a guided raft trip](#) on the Deerfield River.

Dine atop Mount Greylock and enjoy the view from [Bascom Lodge](#) at the summit.

Enjoy an evening performance at MASS MoCA or [Williamstown Theater Festival](#).

DAY THREE:

HILLTOWN ARTIST STUDIOS

Tour [Project Art in Cummington](#) and visit the resident studios of [Sergei Isupov](#) and [Kadri Pärnamets](#). While there, view selected works by other Ferrin Contemporary artists on display in the summer gallery.

Continue on to more studios, Shelburne's [Bridge of Flowers](#), and a drive along the scenic Mohawk Trail.

DAY FOUR:

THE CLARK & WILLIAMSTOWN

Visit the [Williams College Museum of Art](#), Williamstown.

Head over to [The Francine and Sterling Clark Art Institute](#). Enjoy a docent-led tour of the architecture and exhibitions, explore the expansive grounds, and enjoy lunch on the Terrace.
